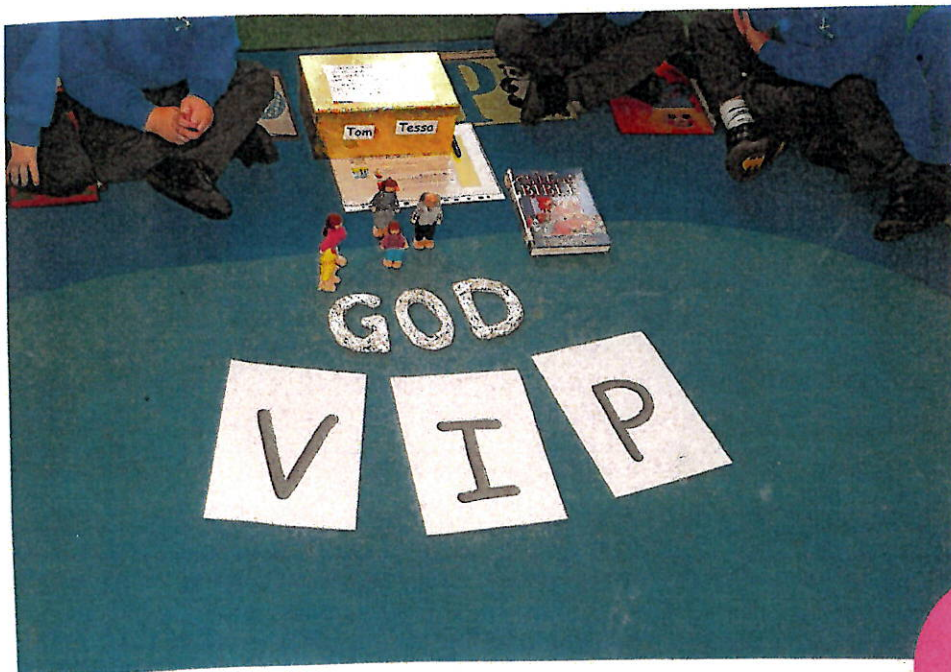
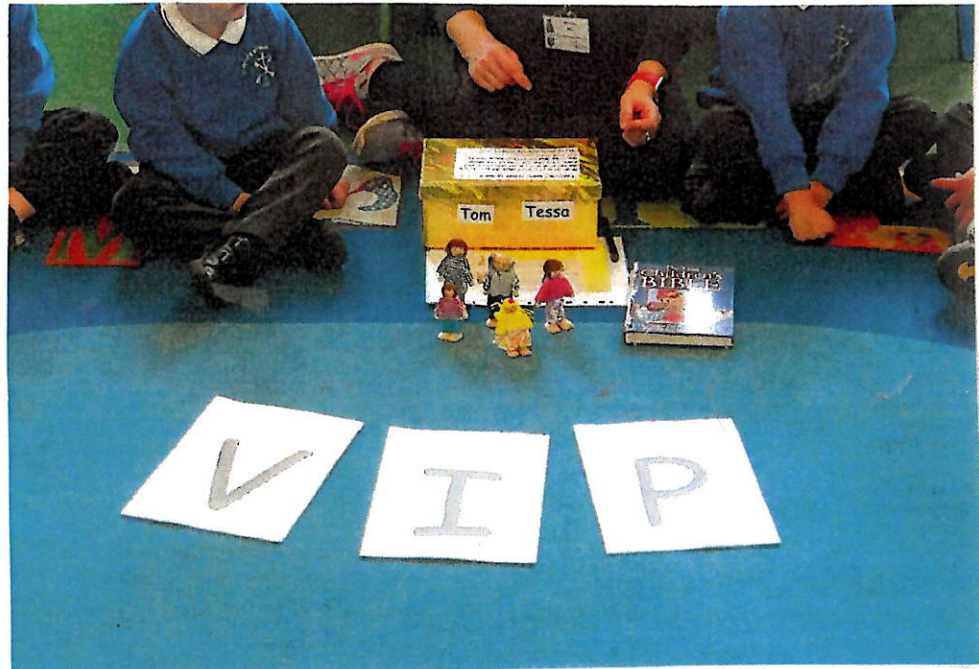
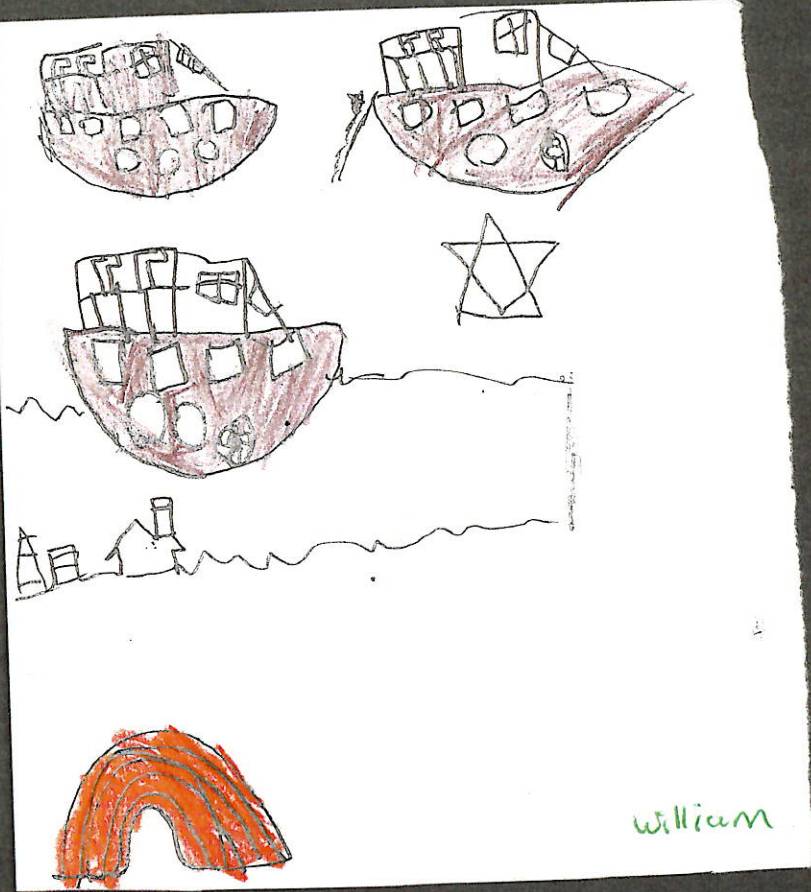


We looked at the word 'GOD' too and talked about what 'invisible' meant.

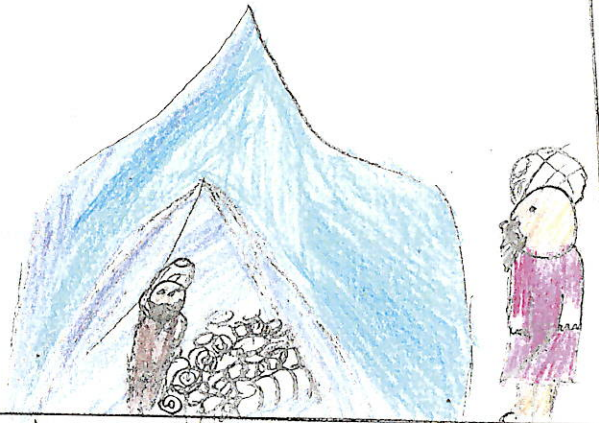
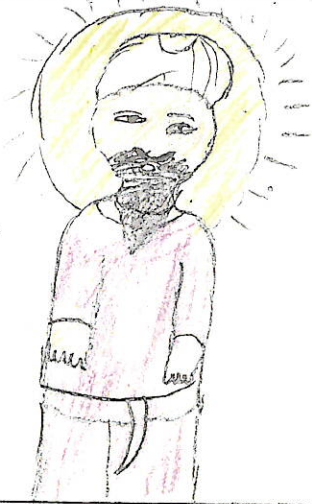

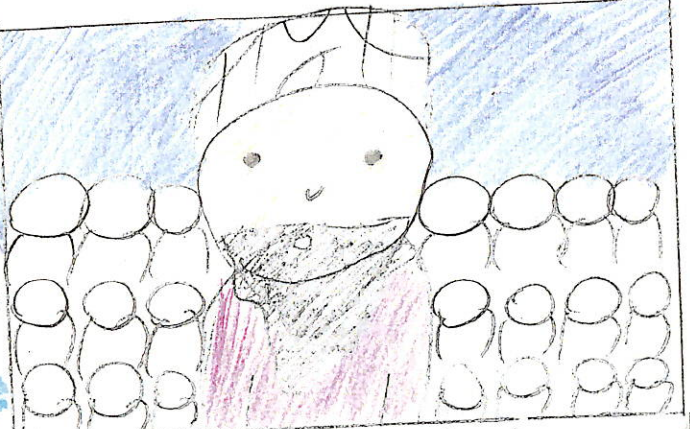


We recreated the story of the Emperors visit in pictures - some do a book.

Who were the ascetics that Siddhartha saw in the forest and what did he learn from them?

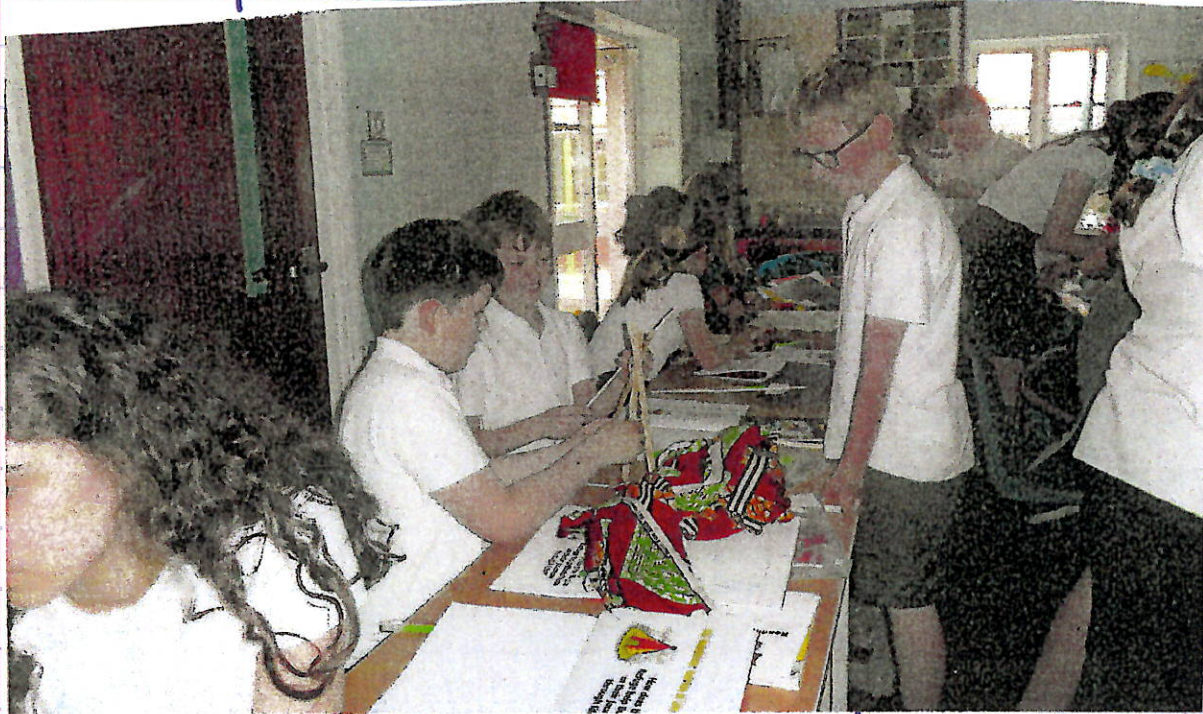
A group of people who Siddhartha thought would enlighten them. What the things that they were doing didn't make any difference.
