## Year 6 Play:

We have started rehearsing the songs and lines for our school play, The Wizard of Oz! ## English:

This half term, we will be writing narratives with dialogue inspired by the animation 'Broken: Rock, Paper Scissors', as well as **biographies** about Charles Darwin to link with our Science topic.

## Maths:

We will be consolidating all that we have learned throughout the year as well as learning calculator skills by completing maths projects with **real-world applications** including budgeting and planning.

## Science:

This half term's science topic is **Evolution and Inheritance**. We will be learning about fossils, exploring how offspring vary, and identifying how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

## Geography:

This half term, we will be finding out **how goods and services are traded around the world**. We will explore the UK's trade links today and in the past, finding out about goods exported and imported and the methods of transport used.

## Computing / D&T:

We will be combining our Computing and D&T skills for our final project of the year: making **interactive pets** using micro:bits!

## PSHE:

Our PSHE topic is '**Changing Me**'. We will be exploring personal hygiene, body image, puberty (for both girls and boys) and conception.

## RE:

This half term, Year 6 will be exploring the question "Why do **Humanists** say happiness is the goal of life?"

## PE:

This half term both classes will be developing their ball skills in **tennis**, and practising **athletics** ready for Sports Day!
