

ASH CLASS - SPRING TERM 2

Maths

This half term we will be continuing our learning about **place value within 50** and moving onto exploring our new topics **Length and Height** followed by **Mass and Volume**. The children will be exploring these topics using hands on activities.

Phonics

We will continue to have daily phonics sessions covering **Phase 5**.

Music

The children will be continuing to explore our '**Exploring Sounds**' topic.

PSHE

The children will explore all the ways they can keep themselves healthy as well as learning out personal hygiene and crossing the road safely as part of our '**Healthy Me**' topic.

Geography

The children will be learning about '**Rainforests**'. We will be locating and identifying where rainforests are on a world map, exploring the different animals who live in rainforests and finding out about the types of weather.

Computing

Our topics this term is '**Pictograms**'.

RE

Hinduism

The children will be exploring the question: **How does a Hindu celebrate devotion to a deity at the festival of Holi?**

English

This half term our fiction focus will be '**Rags to Riches Tales**'. Using Mr Big and Cinderella as texts to explore this topic. The topic will focus on using conjunctions within our writing to add more information. Our non-fiction topic will be **Letter Writing**, we will use our learning surrounding the story of Mr Big to write a letter, focusing on features of a letter.

Science

Our topic this half term is '**Seasonal changes and light**'. The children will be making simple observations and investigations.

PE

The children will have **Forest School** sessions and they will be developing their catching, throwing, rolling, kicking, tracking and stopping a ball as part of their '**Sending and Receiving**' topic.

Art

The children will be studying the famous artist **Kandinsky**.
